1 SECURED DEVELOPMENT FUNDING

We secured a BIG Lottery (People and Places) capital development grant of £47,904 for the Community Hub design and planning process. Our next step is to secure funding for the build.

2 DESIGNED NEW COMMUNITY HUB

We appointed architects Hall + Bednarczyk to design an exciting new space for Raglan in consultation with our community.

3 HELPED TO RUN RAGLAN OLD CHURCH SCHOOL

We ran ROCS on a daily basis on behalf of Monmouthshire County Council. Bookings are up and new services and events include Citizens Advice Bureau sessions, film nights, cookery competitions, a community café and race nights.

4 IMPROVED OUR CURRENT COMMUNITY SPACE

Volunteers refreshed Raglan Old Church School (ROCS) inside and out by tidying, painting and replacing tables. There's new equipment, improved disability access and a WIFI service too.

5 KEPT OUR COMMUNITY ENGAGED & INFORMED


